Requirements for fleece to be entered:

- Each fleece must be in its own clean, clear plastic bag.
- If needed, clear plastic bags will be available the check in table for \$1 cash each.
- Attached securely to each bag must be a tag stating the weight, breed, color, price, and your name or farm name . You may include additional information. Please consider adding any information that will help your fleece sell!
- Fleece that contains excessive vegetable matter, second cuts, feces, or other contaminants may be removed from the sale at the discretion of any HHFF planning committee member or volunteer.
- HHFF will retain a 10% (ten percent) commission from sold fleece.
- HHFF will accept cash or credit card for payment from buyers. Any credit card processing fees will be paid by HHFF.
- Sale proceeds will be remitted to each consignor by check from the HHFF treasurer at the festival when you come to collect.
- Unsold fleeces must be picked up between 4:30 P.M. and 5:30 P.M. Saturday and fleeces not picked up will become the property of HHFF.
- Festival attendees are asked to only open bags and touch fleeces when an HHFF planning committee member or designated volunteer is present. However, this is a large public venue and HHFF, its volunteers, or the Johnson County Fairgrounds, is not responsible for damaged or stolen fleeces.
